3. Discussion Agenda

3.01 Update on Lead in Water at Jeffco Schools (EL-7, 11)

Staff reviewed the steps taken to-date related to proactive testing for lead in the water of elementary schools built prior to 1990 before school begins on August 18. Water sources and drinking fountains found to be above 15 ppb (parts per billion) will be signed "Do Not Drink" and/or deactivated and alternative drinking sources identified. The source of the problem will be determined and plumbing replaced. An informational website has been established through the Jeffco Schools homepage for students, families and community.

3.02 Review of 2016 Bond Issue and Mill Levy Override: Finance Modeling and Content (EL-11)

Motion #2 (Motion to Prepare Ballot Language): Upon motion by Mr. Rupert, second by Ms. Stevens, the Board of Education directed the superintendent to prepare ballot language for approval on August 2 as discussed for bond issue and mill levy override questions on the November 8, 2016 election ballot.

Board members reviewed and discussed the information prepared by staff following the June 16 Board direction on facilities and general fund needs. Review included the capital improvement plan of \$535 million and the finance model to provide for a consistent, predictable tax burden on an annual basis for Jefferson County taxpayers aligned with TABOR provisions flexible enough to capitalize on the current borrowing environment through a wrap structured debt service extending repayment to 25 years from the initially proposed 20 years.
