

JEFFERSON COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT R-1
STATE OF COLORADO

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Public School District R-1 (the "District") is requesting a waiver from that portion of C.R.S. § 22-30.5-107(1)(b) requiring the District to accept charter school applications between August 1st and October 1st (hereinafter, referred to as "Fall Application Cycle");

WHEREAS, the attached waiver application substantially complies with the requirements of C.R.S. § 22-2-117, and requests that the District be permitted to require charter applicants to submit letters of intent by February 1st of each school year and applications by March 15th of each school year, in order to be eligible for consideration to open a charter school in the fall of the following year calendar year (hereinafter, referred to as "Spring Application Cycle"), except as the charter applicant and the local board of education may jointly waive the deadlines set forth in this section by;

WHEREAS, the granting of this waiver is necessary to enhance educational opportunity and quality within the District because the application submission timeline required in the statute does not provide quality charter schools with sufficient time to most effectively open a quality school the following academic year;

WHEREAS, the District is a quality authorizer that holds charter schools accountable through a transparent and rigorous process that uses academic, financial, and operational data;

WHEREAS, allowing a waiver of the Fall Application Cycle enables the District to focus its resources on assessing new charter applications in the spring and assessing charter renewal applications in the fall, thereby most effectively and efficiently supporting schools;

WHEREAS, the District shall comply with the intent of C.R.S. § 22-30.5-107(1)(b) by providing notice of the Spring Application Cycle to all potential applicants and shall be held accountable to the Colorado State Board of Education by providing notice of its Spring Application Cycle and deadlines;

WHEREAS, the District has been granted by the state board exclusive authority to charter schools within its geographic boundaries pursuant to C.R.S. § 22-30.5-504 and is therefore in compliance with C.R.S. § 22-2-117(6);


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that:



CERTIFICATION RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 22-40-102, Colorado Revised Statutes, on or before December 11, 2015, the Board of Education of the Jefferson County School District No. R-1 shall certify to the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson and Broomfield Counties the separate amounts necessary to be raised from levies against the valuation for assessment of all taxable property located within the school district for the General Fund and the Bond Redemption Fund for the current fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Assessor and the Broomfield County Assessor have provided to the Board of Education of the Jefferson County School District No. R-1 a 2015 Certificate of Valuation, and written notice to the School District of refunds and abatements of 2014 taxes paid in 2015, and

WHEREAS, under applicable Colorado law, including the provisions of section 39-10-114, Colorado Revised Statutes, the Board of Education of Jefferson County School District No. R-1 shall adjust its mill levy, as determined under the Public School Finance Act of 1994, section 22-54-101 et seq., Colorado Revised Statutes, to collect revenues lost through previous years' abatements and refunds.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Jefferson County School District No. R-1, Jefferson County, Colorado, herewith authorizes and certifies to the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Jefferson and the County of Broomfield, State of Colorado, the total amount \$331,148,540 to be raised from a levy of 40.737 mills consisting of a standard levy of 26.252 mills pursuant to the Public School Finance Act of 1994, 13.937 mills approved by voters as mill levy overrides, and 0.548 mills for abatements and refunds against the net valuation of assessment in the amount of \$8,128,937,831 for all taxable property located within the boundaries of the School District for the General Fund of the School District for the fiscal period beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2016; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Jefferson County School District No. R-1, Jefferson County, Colorado, herewith authorizes and certifies to the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Jefferson, and the County of Broomfield, State of Colorado, the total amount of \$54,870,330 to be raised from a levy of 6.750 mills against the net valuation of assessment in the amount of \$8,128,937,831 for all taxable property located within the boundaries of the School District for the Bond Redemption Fund of the School District for the fiscal period beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2016; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of the Board of Education be, and is hereby directed to forward the certification for each fund by a copy of this Resolution to the Board of County Commissioners for the County of Jefferson and the County of Broomfield, State of Colorado.

RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT TO ENTER
INTO A LINE OF CREDIT AGREEMENT
WITH A FINANCIAL INSTITUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board (the Board) of Jefferson County School District No. R-1, a political subdivision of the State of Colorado (the District) follows:

WHEREAS, the District is authorized to enter into a non-revolving line of credit agreement (the Agreement) with a financial institution, pursuant to Colorado Statutes, C.R.S. 22-40-107:

WHEREAS, the District has negotiated and reached an Agreement with U.S. Bank National Association (the "Bank"), at the principal office of the Bank in San Francisco; and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of Jefferson County School District No. R-1, State of Colorado, as follows:

1. Upon the effective date of this resolution, the District is hereby authorized to enter into the Agreement with the Bank and thereby, establish a non-revolving line of credit (the "Line") with the Bank whereby the District may initiate draws on the line as provided therein. Final payment of principal and interest shall be due and payable no later than June 1, 2016.
2. The principal amount of the Line will not exceed \$15,000,000.
3. The Superintendent or his designated agent is directed to prepare or execute such documents as may be necessary to comply with the above paragraphs or any other requirements for this Agreement.
