This free event is open to children and teens of all abilities and their families.



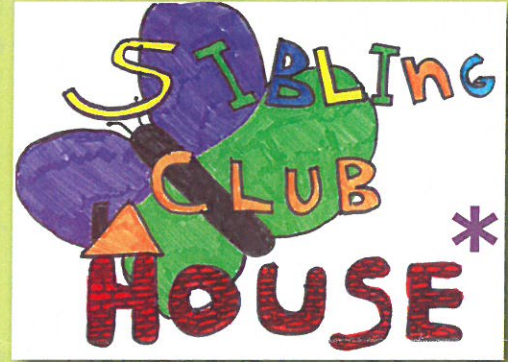
Autism Safety Awareness

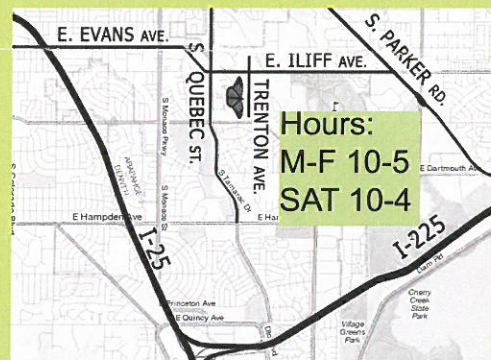
